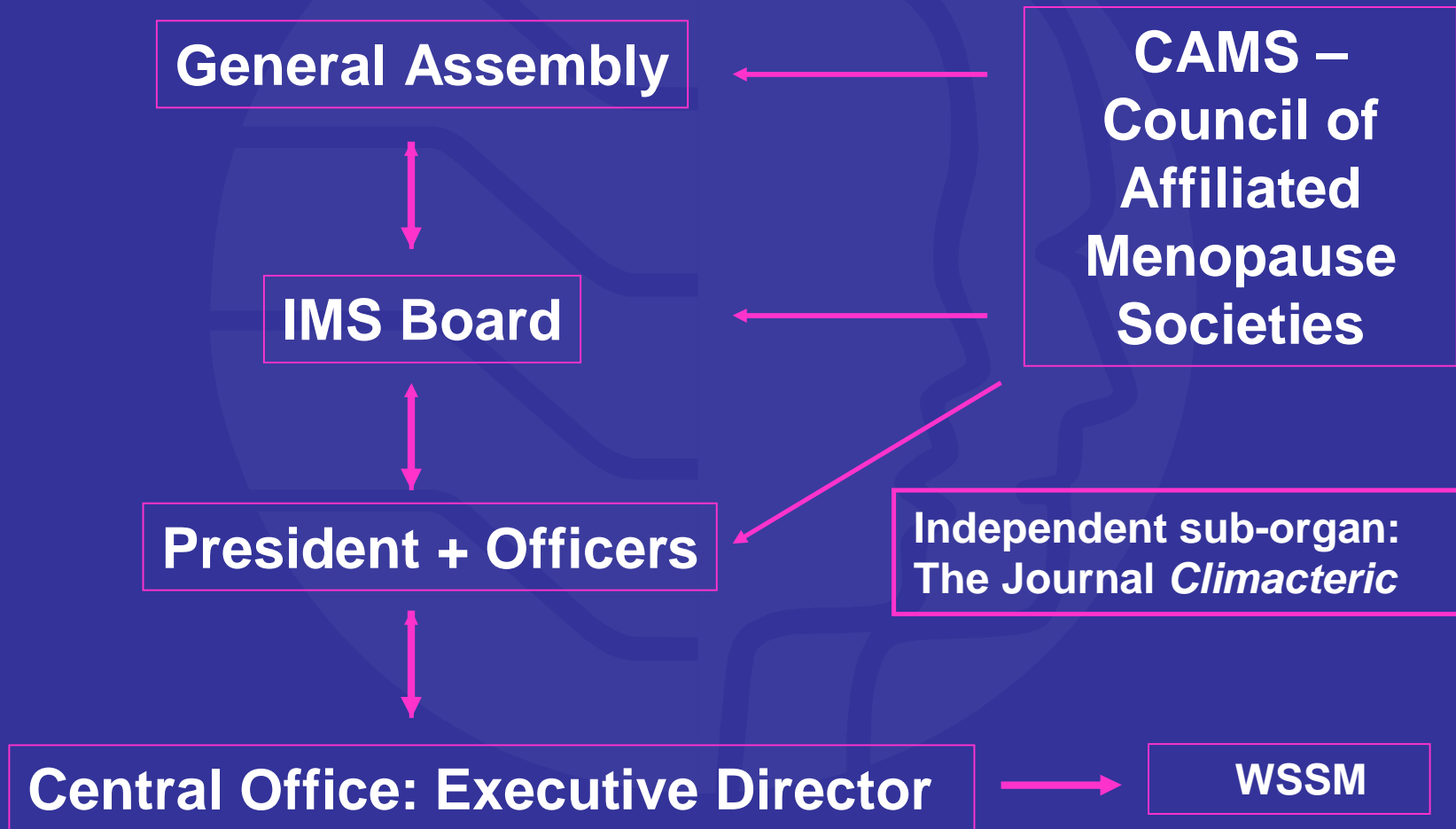

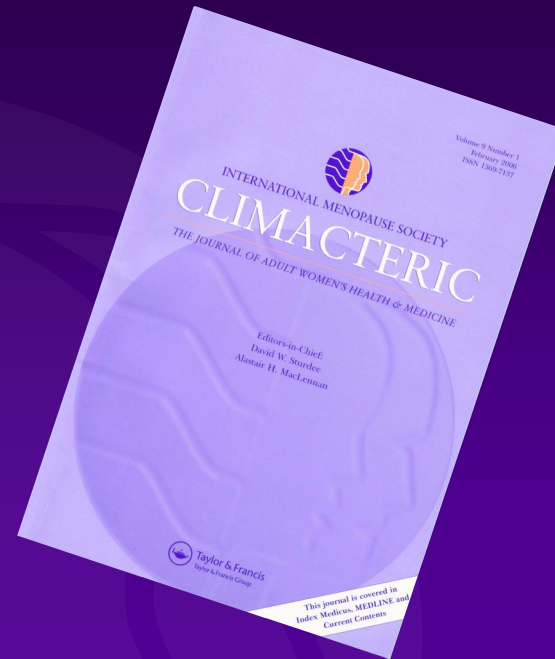


WSSM – World School for the Study of Menopause
